**SUMMARY ANNUAL REPORT  
FOR SHEET METAL WORKERS' LOCAL 73 WELFARE FUND**

This is a summary of the annual report of the Sheet Metal Workers' Local 73 Welfare Fund, EIN 36-2145881, Plan No. 501, for period July 1, 2008 through June 30, 2009. The annual report has been filed with the Employee Benefits Security Administration, U.S. Department of Labor, as required under the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974 (ERISA).

Sheet Metal Workers' Local 73 Welfare Fund has committed itself to pay all eligible claims incurred under the terms of the plan.

**Insurance Information**

The plan has a contract with Symetra Life Insurance Company to pay Stop loss claims incurred under the terms of the plan. The total premiums paid for the plan year ending June 30, 2009 were \$513,247.

**Basic Financial Statement**

The value of plan assets, exclusive of estimated plan obligation liabilities, was \$48,464,828 as of June 30, 2009, compared to \$41,490,546 as of July 1, 2008. During the plan year the plan experienced an increase in its net assets of \$6,974,282. This increase includes unrealized appreciation and depreciation in the value of plan assets; that is, the difference between the value of the plan's assets at the end of the year and the value of the assets at the beginning of the year or the cost of assets acquired during the year. During the plan year, the plan had total income of \$46,443,048 including employer contributions of \$39,116,096, employee contributions of \$6,684,966, realized losses of \$2,055,391 from the sale of assets, earnings from investments of \$553,948 and other income of \$2,143,429.

Plan expenses were \$39,468,766. These expenses included \$2,761,981 in administrative expenses and \$36,706,785 in benefits paid to participants and beneficiaries.

If you request a copy of the full annual report from the plan administrator, these two statements and accompanying notes will be included as part of that report. The charge to cover copying costs given above does not include a charge for the copying of these portions of the report because these portions are furnished without charge.

You also have the legally protected right to examine the annual report at the main office of the plan (Sheet Metal Workers 73 Welfare Fd., 4530 Roosevelt Road, Hillside, IL 60162) and at the U.S. Department of Labor in Washington, D.C., or to obtain a copy from the U.S. Department of Labor upon payment of copying costs.
